SATELITE MEASUREMENT

The entries for the Horn Showcase Satelite Measurement are available on line at TLBAA.org. You can also find them on the CATL.com website. Please be sure to get your entries into the TLBAA for them to receive by September 8, 2011. If you are bringing animals to be measured and are not entering them in the show, please contact us to let us know so we will make accommodations for them.

WORLD QUALIFYING SHOW

Attached you will find Entry Forms, a Summary Form and all other necessary information. Entries should be postmarked no later than **Friday, September 16, 2011.**

CATTLE ACCOMODATIONS: Cattle will be penned in separate pens, with larger animals in one/pen, and smaller animals in 1-3/pen, depending upon total number of entries. Haltered animals may be tied out. **Please note on your Summary Form how many pens or tie-outs you will require.** Bring your own water buckets, hoses, feed and pen cleaning equipment. The Event Center asks that you use shavings for bedding in your pens (straw is not allowed). Hay and shavings can be purchased at the local feed store. Bales of shavings will be available at the pen area for \$5-6.00 per bale.

ENTRY FORMS: All entries must be made on the attached entry form; make as many photocopies as necessary. **Enclose a photocopy of the registration certificate of each animal entered.** For additional information contact Christine DeMaria at 530-796-3402 or email at xcranch@gvni.com or Gail Moore at 229-582-5918 or email at gail@mooreag.com. **HEALTH PAPERS:** Out of State entries will require a health certificate. Have your veterinarian contact the California State Veterinarian for specific requirements

ENTRY FEES: All open show classes are \$35.00/head per class entered. TLBT (Youth) classes are \$5.00/head per class entered. No refunds will be given on entries scratched, but substitutions will be accepted. **Due to the rising cost of the use of facilities a fee of \$5.00 for each head/pair entered is also charged. This fee is based on the number of animals/pairs brought to the show, not on the number of classes entered.**

AWARDS: The top 2 placings in each class in the TLBAA World Qualifying Show and TLBT World Qualifying Show will qualify for the TLBAA World Show and Exposition in Fort Worth, Texas in June 2011. Certificates will be awarded to each exhibitor indicating results. Cash payouts will be given 1st thru 4th place, with the amount dependent upon the number of entries and the overall cost of the Show.

Open Show Premium breakdown: 1st Place – 50%, 2nd Place – 25%, 3rd Place – 15%, 4th Place – 10%

Cash payouts will not be given in the Youth Show. Ribbons will be awarded thru 5th place, and Special Awards will be awarded to the exhibitors of the Grand Champion Female, Grand Champion Bull and Grand Champion Steer and Showmanship.

Two Premier Exhibitor Awards will be given out:

- 1) **Large Herd:** Exhibitors who show 6 or more individual animals.
- 2) **Small Herd:** Exhibitors who show 5 or less individual animals.

In both cases these awards will be limited to individual animals shown in Divisions II and III, and Non-Haltered Bulls and Trophy Steer classes. The awards will apply to the Exhibitor's top 5 placings, as calculated from the schedule below. If an animal is shown in 2 different Divisions or classes, it will be scored only once using the highest points obtainable.

Premier Breeder Award: A Premier Breeder Award will be given to the Exhibitor/Breeder who accumulates the most points according to the schedule below. The top 5 placings of individual animals shown in Division II and III and Non-Haltered Bulls will count; animals exhibited by someone else, but bred by this Exhibitor/Breeder may count toward this award. If an animal is shown in 2 different Divisions or classes, it will be scored only once using the highest points obtainable.

Directions to the Kings Fair, Hanford: Fresno to Hanford is 40 miles - takes 45 - 60 minutes depending on route or traffic. Bakersfield to Hanford is about 90 miles and takes 1 1/2 hours. Paso Robles is about 1 1/2 to 2 hours. LA and SF about 3 1/2 to 4 hours each, depending on where going in each city, so anyone coming further than these locations can just add their travel time to those destinations to figure time to Hanford. Sacramento about 3 to 3 1/2 hours as well.

Best ways to get to Hanford:

From Southern CA connect with I-5 to Hwy 99 and Bakersfield to Hwy 198 to Hanford - take the 10th Avenue exit and go left to the Fair Grounds.

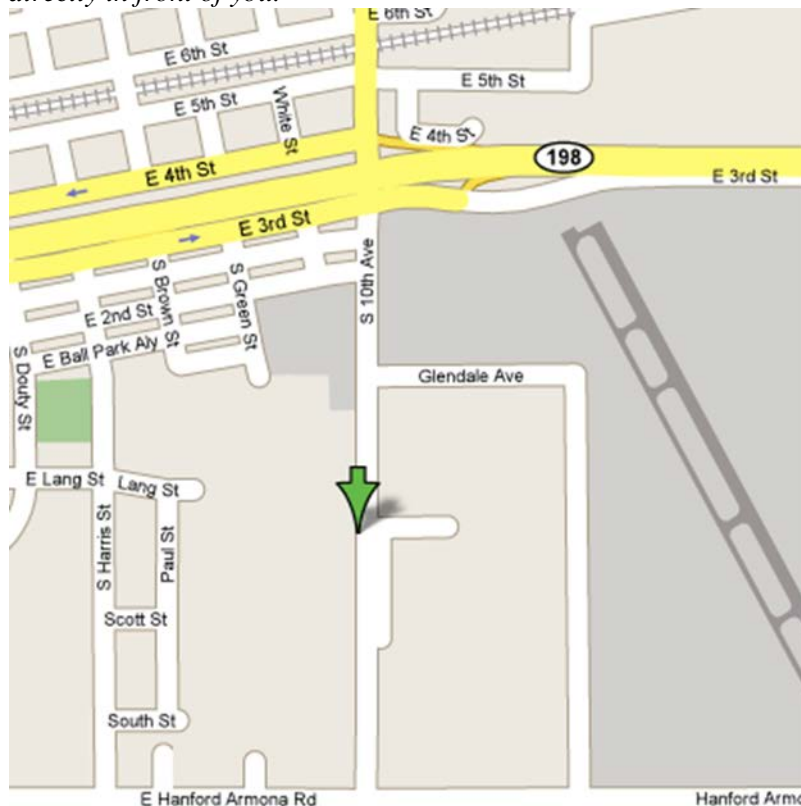
From Northern CA (central area) go Hwy 99 to either Hwy 41 exit @ Fresno to 198 exit @ Lemoore then stay on 198 to 10th Ave exit.

OR take Hwy 43 exit @ Selma, to north edge of Hanford and turn at the 1st exit to your right (this is just as the highway will be curving to the southeast of Hanford), which would be 10th Ave. and just go straight to Fair Grounds. If you miss the first exit, go on to Hwy 198, exit to your right and go to the 10th Avenue exit, go left on 10th Avenue.

From Bay Area go I-5 to 198 - take the exit that will have a sign posted for the Fair Grounds, stay on the access road until 10th Avenue, go right on 10th.

From Central Coast go Hwy 46 to Hwy 41 to Hwy 198 - take the exit that will have a sign posted for the Fair Grounds, stay on the access road until 10th Avenue, go right on 10th.

For All: Once you are on 10th Avenue headed south, go to the stop light @ Hanford-Armona Road, make a left and watch for the 1st gate into the Livestock area on your left. Take that gate in and the unloading area will be directly in front of you.



The Best Western in Lemoore: From I-5/Hwy 41: Take Hwy 198 est, exit Houston Avenue, and turn left. Hotel located on left @ corner of D and Bush St.

From Hwy 99 or Hanford: Take Hwy 198 west, exit D St. Proceed west on D St., hotel located on the left. Phone #: 559-924-3200.
